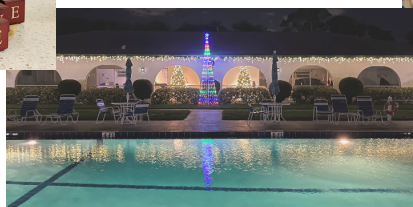

TEQUESTA GARDEN COMMUNITY SPOTLIGHT:

At the August 2022 Board Meeting, the Board of Directors approved a change to the Tequesta Garden Rules and Regulations regarding smoking. The Board had received several complaints from residents that secondhand smoke was wafting into their home and having a negative impact on their enjoyment of their property. Please be aware of the restrictions on smoking in the community and respect your neighbors by ensuring that you and your guests comply with these regulations. The full text as it appears in the Rules and Regulations follows:

Smoking and secondhand smoke are nuisances as well as fire, health and safety hazards. Smoking anywhere on the property cannot create a nuisance for residents. Smoking includes, for example, the use of cigarettes, cigars, pipes, marijuana, e-cigarettes, and vaping. The State of Florida Clean Indoor Air Act prohibits smoking in common enclosed areas, such as laundry rooms and clubhouses, including restrooms and kitchens. Smoking and secondhand smoke are also not permitted on balconies, walkways, and the Clubhouse's screened porch. Smoking is permitted in individual units but must be contained within the unit and cannot become a nuisance to neighboring units or interfere with the peaceful possession and use of the property by its residents. Cigarette butts and ashes are considered litter and should be disposed of properly.

Please be advised that these are the only items that should be placed in the 2 recycle bins behind the Clubhouse:

PAPER / CARDBOARD RECYCLE BIN:

Cardboard - **Flattened**
Newspapers and Inserts - No plastic bags
Office and School Paper
Mail
Magazines
Dry Food Boxes - No food stains
Paper Bags
Cardboard Paper Rolls
Pizza Boxes - No food stains

PLASTIC / GLASS BIN:

Plastic Bottles and Containers
Lids on; 2 gallons or less
Cans, Food and Beverage
Glass Bottles and Jars - Lids off
Cartons, Milk and Juice -

Plastic Bags
Foam Products
Aluminum Foil or Pans
Shredded Paper
Plastic Eating Utensils or Straws
Paper Plates
Paper Towels or Napkins
Coat Hangers
